Sir,

I am to inform you that certain students who passed all the Semesters of LL B 3 (ydc) and LL M 2( ydc) except study of final Semester or Final Year of their course within time frame requested to accord permission in relaxation of time frame as they suffered a lot due to pandemic Covid 19 situation prevailed during the last two academic years 2019-2021.

All such applications have been referred to the Committee constituted to look into the provisions vis-à-vis the genuineness of the pleas so as to take appropriate decision vide reference cited. The Committee recommended to give one time permission to the students who could not study their Final Semester/Year of study within time frame to get readmission for the year 2022-2023 without making it a precedent in future. The rules of readmission/promotion and time frame of the courses remain unaltered.

Based on the recommendations of the Committee and in view of urgency, the Vice-Chancellor in anticipation of ratification by the Standing Committee of the Academic Senate has accorded one time approval to all the students of Law Courses who passed all semesters but could not study the final Semester or year of the course within time frame by 2021-2022 to get readmission to Final Semester or Year of the course for the academic year 2022-2023 as per the procedures in vogue without making it a precedent in future. The rules of admission/readmission/promotion and time frame of the courses remain unaltered.

It may please be brought to the notice of the students and staff of your college concerned and action may be initiated accordingly.
