Sir,

I am to inform you that certain students who pursued all the Semesters of UG Courses except study of final Semester / Final Year of their course within time frame requested to accord permission to finish their course in relaxation of time frame as they suffered a lot due to pandemic Covid 19 situation prevailed during the last two academic years 2019-2021.

On similar requests from Law Students, a Committee constituted to look into the provisions vis-à-vis the genuineness of the please so as to take appropriate decision vide reference 2nd cited. The committee recommended to give one time permission to the students who could not study their Final Semester / Year of study within time frame to get readmission for the year 2022-2023 without making it a precedent in future. The rules of readmission/promotion and time frame of the courses remain unaltered.

in view of the above, the Vice - Chancellor in anticipation of ratification by the Standing Committee of the Academic Senate has accorded approval to all the students of UG (NP) Courses who passed all Semesters, but could not study the final Semester or Year of the course within time frame by 2021-2022 to avail one time chance to get readmission to Final Semester Year of the course for the academic year 2022-2023 as per the procedures in vogue without making it a precedent in future. The rules of admission/ readmission/ promotion and time frame of the courses remain unaltered.
