Sir,

Vide memo cited under reference 1, the State Government has instructed to all the Higher Educational Institutions, viz., Government, Constituent, Aided, and Private Affiliated colleges, for mandatory implementation of the Aadhar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) for the students as well as staff for calculating the attendance across the state as required for promoting the students to the higher classes and also for the purpose of their e-pass scholarships and fee reimbursements, etc., after normalizing the conditions disturbed by COVI-19.

In this context, this office had conversations with your office personnel with regard to the restoration of biometric machines that were already installed in colleges before the lock-down of establishments due to the prevalence of COVID-19. Accordingly, the Vice-Chancellor has accorded approval for the resumption of "Biometric Attendance" (AEBAS) in all the colleges and offices under the jurisdiction of Kakatiya University with the technical support and maintenance mechanism of your firm as per the administrative sanction orders issued by this university vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited.

In this regard, I request that you instruct the technical personnel concerned to visit all the colleges (Government, Constituent, Aided, and Private Affiliated colleges) and offices under the jurisdiction of Kakatiya University for the restoration of biometric machines according to their strengths. Further, I am herewith attaching the list of colleges for your perusal.
