- vi) The exact time at which the Chief Superintendent or Invigilator discovered the candidate guilty of malpractice.

The report should be filled up by the Invigilator and countersigned the Chief Superintendent with his own remarks and opinion on the case. This report should also be accompanied whether possible, by a statement made by the candidate himself/herself in writing and of all papers seized from him/her. The answer book of candidates resorting to malpractice should be forwarded to the Controller of Examinations along with this report. The seating plan of Examination Hall where the candidate was caught resorting to malpractice must also be sent along with this.
