RULES FOR REVALUATION OF SCRIPTS

- 1. The application with prescribed fee for revaluation of answer script should be submitted upto **20 days** from the date of issue of Memo of Marks.
- 2. The answer book will be revalued independently by an examiner chosen from outside the University area.
- 3. If the difference is less than 10% of maximum marks between the original marks and the marks given by the examiners valuing the paper, the original marks will stand good.
- 4. If the difference is 10% but not more than 20% between the original marks and the marks given by the examiner who revalued the answer paper, the marks given on revaluation will be taken as the marks of the candidate.
- 5. If the difference exceeds more than **20%** even on second revaluation, the average of the two revaluation marks shall be awarded to the candidate.
