I am to inform you that the Vice-Chancellor, in anticipation of the approval of the Standing Committee of the Academic Senate, has accorded approval for the implementation of the following model question paper for Under-Graduate (Non-Professional) courses under Choice Based Credit System from the academic year 2016-2017:-

FACULTY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES AND COMMERCE & BUSINESS MANAGEMENT:

Section – A: 5/8 (Eight short questions are to be given out of which 5 are to be answered) $5 \times 4 = 20$

Section – B: 5 Essay Type Questions with internal choice of two from each unit. $5 \times 12 = 60$

Maximum Marks: 80

FACULTY OF SCIENCE:

(I to IV papers only)

Section – A: 8/12 (Twelve short questions are to be given out of which 8 are to be answered) $8 \times 4 = 32$

Section – B: 4 Essay Type Questions with internal choice of two from each unit. $4 \times 12 = 48$

Maximum Marks: 80

(V to VIII papers only)

Section – A: 8/12 (Twelve short questions are to be given out of which 8 are to be answered) $8 \times 4 = 32$

Section – B: 4 Essay Type Questions with internal choice of two from each unit. $4 \times 7 = 28$

Maximum Marks: 60

FACULTY OF ARTS:

Section – A: 4/6 (Six short questions are to be given out of which 4 are to be answered) $4 \times 5 = 20$

Section – B: 4 Essay Type Questions with internal choice of two from each unit. $4 \times 15 = 60$

Maximum Marks: 80

Further, I am to inform that the rules of promotion and pass in vogue for 3 YDC UG shall be applicable to Choice Based Credit System also.
