### 4.2 UNIVERSITY LIBRARY

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

Kakatiya University, Warangal was established in 1976 by upgrading the then P.G. Centre of the Osmania University originally started in 1967. The main objective behind the establishment of this University was to provide educational facilities to the people of Northern Telangana, a backward region of Andhra Pradesh.

From 1967 to 1982, books were acquired by the University Library but maintained in the respective departments. (i.e., issuing and maintenance). It was on 18th November 1967 that the first book was entered in the annals of library records.

Having felt the need for establishing a University Library for optimum utilization of library collection, University Library Building was constructed during the period of Prof. K. Venkat Ramaiah, the first Vice-Chancellor of Kakatiya University widely considered the architect of the University. The building was inaugurated in the year 1982.

Subsequently, the collection of erstwhile departmental libraries was pooled and open access system introduced in place of closed access system. The prime function of the University Library is to provide study and research facilities to the Students, Research Scholars and Faculty members of the University. The Library, which was started with this humble aim, made rapid strides over the years and has grown into the present University Library. It is one of the big libraries in this area catering to the needs of the students and scholars of not only the University Campus but also of all colleges under Kakatiya University jurisdiction.

The University Library was centralized in the year 1982. After centralization the University Library has taken up various library services in view of the growing needs of the library and demands of users, several sections have been created to facilitate proper organization and maintenance of the library.

Annual Report 2011-2012 The library functions throughout the year barring festival holidays. During all working days the library operates in three shifts from 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m. and on Sundays and Second Saturdays from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. to cater to the needs of the users. During the examination time the library hours are extended up to 12.00 p.m. late nights. On an average per day 300 users avail the library SECTIONS

### 2.1 ADMINISTRATION

The main function of this section is planning, development and management of the library which involve general maintenance of the library, budget control, staff management, processing of bills, library correspondence, maintenance of office records, shifts arrangement and coordination with University administration, departments and other offices.

### 2.2 ACQUISITION OF BOOKS

There are 24 departments on the campus having an annual book grant of Rs.20,000/- each and Rs.1.25 lakh to the library for the purchase of reference books. The self-finance programmes allocate 10% of grant towards the purchase of books from the total receipts of the year and books purchased under Self-finance course programme are maintained in the concerned departments.

#### 2.3. TECHNICAL SECTION

All the books acquired by the library are processed scientifically for their arrangement in the stack rooms. DDC & AACR2 are used. The catalogue cards and data input sheets are prepared in this section by the professional staff. With the help of these input sheets the database of books is being updated in SOUL software, which is designed and developed by INFLIBNET, Ahmedabad and NewGenLib software is also acquired.

#### 2.4 REFERENCE & TEXTBOOK SECTION

Reference sources like Encyclopedias, Dictionaries, Directories, Year-Books, Hand-Books, Statistical Sources, Biographical Sources, Geographical Sources and Reports are the reference sources maintained properly in this section. Apart from reference books important, valuable textbooks are also being maintained in this section. In addition, SC Book Bank, ST Book Bank also maintained in this section. The SC Book Bank was established with the funds provided by the social welfare department. The ST Book Bank was established with the ITDA funds in 2007. The Doctoral Theses and M.Phil. Dissertations of the Kakatiya University are maintained properly in this section. This section functions from 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m.

#### 2.5 PERIODICALS SECTION

An amount of Rs.5.50 lakhs has been provided in the budget for subscription of research journals every year. The library subscribes to 125 Foreign and Indian Journals. Current issues are displayed subject wise and back volumes in bound form are maintained faculty wise. There are 30,360 back volumes in this section.

The University Library maintains open access system. The readers can select and use books, 2.6 STACK ROOMS according to their choice. One stack is meant in for social sciences, humanities and commerce, and another stack for science and technology.

2.7 CIRCULATION SECTION The circulation section looks after the work of registration of borrowers, issue of borrower cards, maintenance of relevant records, reservation of books on demand, collection of overdue charges and reminding the borrowers for returning books after the due date and finally issuing of no-dues certificates. Books are issued to the teachers, research scholars, staff and students based on their eligibility to borrow the books. This section serves about 400 to 450 clientele on an average daily. Faculty members, research scholars, students and staff are members of the library and more than 40,000 books are circulated every year. On an average Rs.6,000/- are being collected as over due charges per annum and remitted to the fund account. Books being issued to Readers through the Automated System.

# 2.8 COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION MATERIAL CELL

In order to encourage the students to prepare for competitive examinations and seek jobs an exclusive section has been created in the library. The magazines and books are acquired relating to national and state level recruitment tests such as UPSC, APPSC, NET, Banking, Railways, and LIC. Various employment notifications, forth-coming conferences, admission notifications would be displayed on the notice board to help the readers. The material available in this section is being fully utilized by the students to plan their career development and for seeking employment. Many students who used this section secured jobs.

# 2.9 NEWSPAPERS AND MAGAZINES SECTION

The library subscribes 12 English, 10 Telugu Newspapers covering national, regional and local papers and the magazines are received in the library, which include competitive and social, economic, political and cultural.

#### 3.

The INFLIBNET has supplied the SOUL library application, a software package developed INFLIBNET by itself. It is also provided training to a few library personnel at managerial level, to the Deputy Librarian and at operational level to the Library Assistants.

The library has LAN and the following divisions:

- e-Journals Section 1.
- Database Management Section (DBM) 2.
- INTERNET Service Section 3.
- Library Automation

Further, the library is also coming under the fold of UGC-INFONET, which is aimed to enhance the network, and communication infrastructure at universities to have more access to various information sources available at national and international level.

#### 3.1. c-JOURNALS SECTION

More than 12,650 free e-Journals facility is available for access to the scholars and faculty sponsored by UGC -INFONET(INFLIBNET) to the all the departments through the campus network.

#### 3.2 DATABASE MANAGEMENT SECTION

The work involved in the section is to create, update, maintain and manage the various databases as per the INFLIBNET programme and local needs; planning for automation of library services and their implementation.

As a part of this, several databases are planned and created out of the resources available in the library. These are:

- 1. Books Database
- 2. Theses Database
  - a. M.Phil. Dissertations
  - b. Ph.D. Theses
- 3. Periodicals Database
  - a. Current Journals
  - b. Back Volumes
- 4. Experts Database

In this section, a book database of more than 85,159 records have been created. The work is in progress for the remaining books. The theses database is completed and has been sent to INFLIBNET to keep in the National Database. Further the dissertation data base is under process.

#### 3.3 COMPUTER & INTERNET SECTION

35 Thin client systems were added to library with UGC XI Plan Funds for the use of Internet, digitization and automation.

The work involved in this section is to provide Internet access and E-mail communication and Networking of the library. Internet connectivity has been taken through BSNL Leased Line which is provided by the Ministry of Human Resource and Development, New Delhi. The literature search facility to the Research Scholars and Faculty is provided to give thrust to research activities.

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The access to various databases is provided to the members allowing them to send/receive E-mail communications. The membership fee is Rs.100/- per annum to the students and research scholars; and Rs.200/- per annum to the faculty/staff. The LAN within the library is planned and extended to some sections from this section.

The orientation classes to the participants of various academic programmes are being conducted in this section.

At present we have provided 15 systems to the Internet Section. More than 500 members have registered for this service. There is more demand for this membership. This service is provided from 11.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. Recently the Internet services has been merged with University Computer Centre which is located in the new Library building.

#### 3.4 LIBRARY AUTOMATION

The Library has initiated automation work and about 85,159 records were entered so far. Automated circulation is being introduced. Total automation process is likely to be completed shortly.

#### 4. READING HALL

One reading hall exclusively in the new Library building is open for 24 hours to the readers with all facilities. Large section of students utilizing this facility.

#### 5. CONCLUSION

With the available funds, staff and infrastructure, the library is poised to bloom into an automated library with all improved modern facilities and services to its clientele.

#### 4.3 YOGA CENTRE

A Yoga Centre sponsored by the UGC was established on the Kakatiya University campus in December 2000. To run the activities of the yoga Centre, the University administration has provided the required staff, accommodation and equipment.

A few extension lectures were arranged by the Yoga Centre for the benefit of the staff and the students of the University. Some eminent personalities in the Yoga filed have delivered the extension lectures.

A New Yoga Therapy wing at the yoga Center was established. It possesses several instruments and facilities for the therapeutic services which are available for the use of the staff and the students of our University.

The university has allocated an annual budget of Rs. 50,000/- towards contingency and maintenance of Yoga Centre. The funds are used for conducting the extension lectures, National Seminars as well as for the maintenance of the centre.

The staff of Yoga Centre have been working with utmost commitment and dedication to spread the awareness of Yoga and its application to the staff and students of the university as well as the general public of the society.
