Republic Day Greetings.

Higher education aims at shaping careers as well as minds. Right kind of ambience is needed for that to happen: courses, quality, expertise and facilities. Frontline universities the world over could boast of these and sustain them over a period of time. Years of dedicated work and concerted efforts are needed to make a beginning in that direction. Our university getting accredited with "A" Grade by the NAAC in 2009 shows that we have made a beginning. To further strengthen the system and improve



academics with innovative courses and programmes we must sustain the tempo with collective efforts. I appeal to all the stakeholders in the university to work with more dedication keeping the Re-accreditation by the NAAC in near future. The physical facilities, especially hostel facilities for the students will receive a big boost during this Plan period.

Taking cognizance of this, everyone has to introspect whether one has contributed to the growth of the University in any manner possible. Those lagging behind must raise the bar to keep pace with the momentum. The young staff members must look up to good role models and mould their career that way. The Kaktiya University College of Pharmaceutical Sciences organized a three day International Conference on "Recent Advances in Pharmaceutical Sciences (RAPS-2012)" during November 22-24, 2012. Scores of Scientists from Pharmacy across the nation and abroad took part in the seminar. Addressing the delegates at the inauguration of the conference as Chief Patron University Vice-Chancellor Prof. B. Venkat Rathnam said that the purpose of research in any field should be for the welfare of the mankind.

Pharmaceutical Sciences is an area of scientific work that encompasses unlimited opportunities. Participating in the inaugural session Prof.Colin W.G. Fishwick of University of Leeds, U.K. said that in India research in the field of pharmacy is being carried at international standards with excellent lab facilities. It is a good sign that more and more students are opting for pharmacy courses, he said. Delivering the keynote address on "Nano Particle as drug delivery systems for the brain" Prof. Jorg Kreuter, Goethe University, Frankfurt, Germany said that nano particles delivery reduces the dose drastically as the drug is spefically delivered to the target tissues and has a low toxity and lower rate of adverse effects. Prof. Jagath Kanwar, Deakin University, Australia addressing the gathering said that new discoveries especially in cancer with minimal side effects is the key of current research in pharmaceutical sciences. Six Plenary Lectures by foreign scientists and 18 lectures have been arranged in the seminar for the benefit of the participants.




Popular Lecture on DNA sequencing

The A.P. Academy of Sciences, Warangal Regional Centre at Kakatiya University organized a popular lecture on "How do we sequence our DNA: Past present and the future" by Dr. Ch. Mohan Rao, Director, CCMB, Hyderabad on 6.11.2012 in the Senate Hall of the University. Taking a drop of blood, the whole history of human health and how it would help avoid diseases and change our lives, he explained. P.V. Narasimha Rao Endowment Lecture

Padmashri D.R. Karthikeyan, former CBI Director and Director General, NHRC delivered the second Endowment Lecture in memory of late P.V. Narasimha Rao, former Prime Minister of India on Wednesday, 5th December, 2012 at Kakatiya University Senate Hall. Delivering lecture on "Terrorism and Human Rights" he said that human rights are relevant to terrorism as it concerns both its victims and its perpetrators. The innocent victims of terrorism suffer an attack on their most basic right to life and to live in peace and security, Kaarthikeyan said. The perpetrators as members of human family have the right not to be subjected to torture or other degrading treatment, the right to be presumed innocent until they are deemed guilty of the crime. There is a need to punish terrorists and extremists, but at the same time sincere attempts should be made to find out the root of the problem. In recent years, the measures adopted by states to counter terrorism have often posed serious challenges to human rights and the rule of law, he opined.

There is now a growing realization to combat terrorism at a global level. It is fuelled by internal participation and external back-ups. If there is to be justice and peace on the earth, it must begin with each one of us personally, Kaarthikeyan said. Presiding over the programme University Vice-Chancellor said that our acts should reflect human welfare and uphold human rights.
