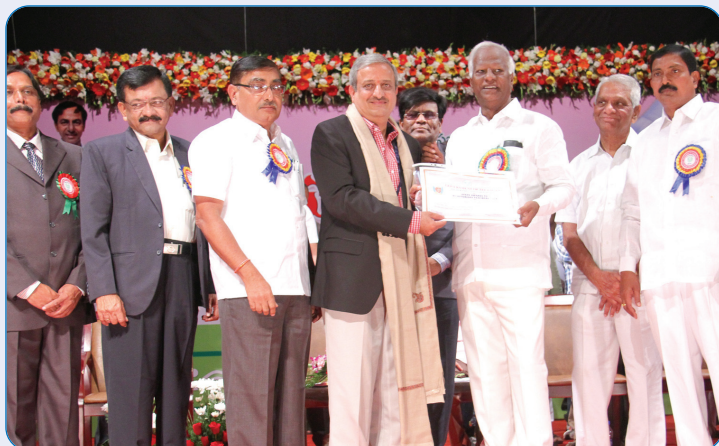


## Prof. M.V.Ranga Rao the New Registrar

## PG, Degree Colleges enter MoU with SAP

Five PG and Degree Colleges under the jurisdiction of Kakatiya University have entered into MoU with most widely used popular software SAP for training of their students in collaboration with TASK (Telangana Academy of Skill and Knowledge). At a special meeting held in Senate Hall of Kakatiya University on September 29, 2016, the representatives of Five PG-Degree Colleges, TASK and SAP exchanged the MoU papers. Speaking at the meeting University Incharge Registrar Prof. G. Benerjee exhorted the PG and Degree Colleges to avail the programmes offered to improve the employability of their students. Very minimal percentage of students who are graduated from the universities are placed in the companies, he pointed out. Such programmes are specially designed to make the students equip for the industry requirements would be beneficial to the students, he said. He appreciated the initiation and efforts of TASK and the state government in this aspect. CEO of TASK Mr. Sujiv Nair said that in the first phase they have offered training in ABAP and MM modules of SAP to engineering students that yielded good results. Now that the TASK has designed a special module of SAP-FICO for Commerce students of Degree and PG students at a minimal fee. Under this agreement the SAP in collaboration with IPA would offer training programme in the respective colleges and award certificates too, he said. This programme is first of its kind in India and being launched in Warangal for the first time. Representatives from TASK, SAP, IPA and representatives of colleges took part in the programme.

## Refreshers Course in Experimental Physics

Srinivasn, Retired professor of IIT, Chennai said that the main objective of the programme is to modify the existing experimental techniques and to introduce some new equipment for conducting experimental classes of B.Sc., B.Tech., M.Sc. ## Dr. Jayashankar Endowment Lecture

The Fourth Endowment Lecture in memory of late Dr. K. Jayashankar was held on August 6, 2016. Human Rights Activist Dr. V. Varavara Rao spoke on "Telangana Bhasha, Sanskruthi and Sahithyam" in the Senate Hall of the University. He said that the Telangana Literature has a legacy of atleast three thousand years. For hundreds of years, Telangana has been epicentre for Telugu Literature, but started diminishing from 1956 onwards. Palkurki Somana, Bammara Pothana among many others stand as icons of Telangana Language and Literature. He stressed the need to protect Telugu language and literature. Dr. Jayashankar lead the non-mulki movement and also the second phase of Telangana Movement actively. Dr Varavarao praised the roles of writers, poets and lyricists for their role in the recent Telangana movement. Returning to his friendship with Dr. Jayashankar during their days as teachers in CKM College, he said though their political ideologies were different, they shared a rapport on literary subjects. Presiding over the lecture programme, University Vice-Chancellor, Prof. R. Sayanna said that Dr. Jayashankar made remarkable contribution to the development of Kakatiya University as Registrar and Vice-Chancellor. Former Vice-Chancellor Prof. N. 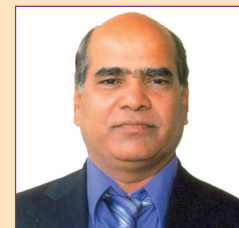

## Prof. C. Sivarama Krishna Rao Memorial Lecture

The Department of Economics organised the first memorial lecture of Prof. C. Siva Rama Krishna Rao, Retired Professor of Economics and former Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences on 5th December, 2016 in the Senate Hall of the University. Noted Social Scientist Prof. G. Haragopal, gave a talk on "Demonetization Effects on Indian Economy." He opined that political consideration played a key role than any economic rule behind the Union Government's demonetisation move. Demonetisation is just a diversion tactic, he said. He felt that the real issue is for the government to address imbalances in economic development of citizens in the country. Discussions should take place why there are still super rich, poor and jobless youth, why hunger and poverty is still lingering. He pointed out that one lakh acres of land is in the hands of just 16 persons in Hyderabad. One per cent of the super rich in the country controls nation's wealth. Currency is not the only source of black money, it is stacked away in the form of gold, land and diamonds and others, he added. Prof. Haragopal expressed qualms over the claims by centre and state governments creating cashless and digital economy. He lauded the patience of the public in dealing with demonetisation blues. University Vice-Chancellor, Prof. R. Sayanna, Dr. B.R. Open University Vice-Chancellor Prof. K. Seetharama Rao, Sathavahana University former Vice-Chancellor Prof. Md. Iqbal Ali, Dr. B. Suresh Lal took part in the programme.

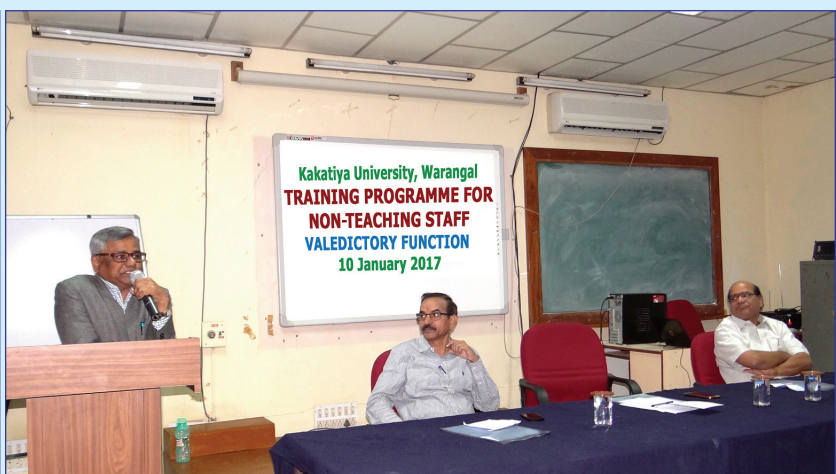


## MS Acharya Endowment Lecture

Eminent Educationalist and former MLC Dr. Chukka Ramaiah spoke on "Role of the Press in Telangana Development." University Vice-Chancellor, Prof. R. Sayanna presided over the programme.
