TA/DA/incidental charges to Outstation participants

Teacher participants may be paid A/C III railway fare (all trains) or A/C deluxe bus fare on production of tickets. Outstation participants may be provided free boarding and lodging by the University. To cover the cost of their boarding/ lodging, the Commission will pay the University Rs. 300/- per day for outstation participant for 'A' class cities, Rs. 250/- per day for other places. In case only free lodging is provided, DA will be allowed at 75 percent of the ordinary rate of daily allowance. In case the outstation participant does not avail the facility for boarding/lodging, he/she will be paid Rs. 250/- per day.

LOCAL PARTICIPANTS:

Rs. 100/- per working day per participant will be paid to the HRDC for providing hospitality. In case a local participant does not avail the facility of hospitality by the HRDC, he/she will be paid Rs. 100/- per working day.

Selection Criteria:

Selection will be done based on *first-come-first-serve basis* to a maximum number of 60. The list of selected participants will be intimated through E-mail.

Introduction:

The UGC-Human Resource Development Centre (formerly known as UGC-Academic Staff College), Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad, was established in the year 2000 and sponsored by University Grants Commission, New Delhi. The UGC HRDC organizes Orientation Programmes, Faculty Induction Programmes, Refresher Courses, Short Term Courses and Workshops on thrust areas for in-service teachers and also for newly appointed teaching faculty on a regular basis, to update the knowledge and skills in their respective fields.

- Adopt flexible evaluation processes which are more specific to evaluate multiple skills and competencies of students.
- Promote four possible types of faculty development: personal (interpersonal skills, career development, and life planning issues); instructional (course design and development, instructional technology); organisational (ways to improve the institutional environment to better support teaching); and professional (ways to support faculty members so that they fulfill their multiple roles of teaching, research and service).
- To promote academic excellence, teaching innovation, research capabilities and leadership skills.
- To promote the professional capability and performance of teachers to deliver effective and quality learning.

During the current academic year 2022-2023, the Faculty Induction Programme-12 is proposed to be organized during 23-01-2023 to 23-02-2023, in offline mode. The number of participants is limited to a maximum of 60, and the selection will be based on the priority of 'first -come-first-serve'.

Eligibility:
