1. The University has a policy to construct Ramps to enable the physically challenged people to enter the buildings.
2. The University has a dedicated Health Care Centre with a Visiting Gynaecologist and a Lady Nurse to provide Maternity Care to the women.
3. The University has a policy in force to reserve 5% of the admission intake for the physically challenged people.

This has reference to the directives of the Government of Telangana (Ref.1) and as desired by your kind office (Ref.2), and as suggested by the Women, Children, Disabilities, Senior Citizens Department (WCD&SC) Department, Government of Telangana (ref.3) for implementation of the provisions of Section 32 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 (Central Act No. 49), "32(1 & 2)".

Now, in pursuance of the decision taken by the Standing Committee of Academic Senate in its meeting held on 30 January 2019, I am to inform you that starting the academic year 2019-20, it is resolved to implement the "Supreme Court Directions on the provisions of Section 32 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 (Central Act No. 49), "32(1 & 2)" (enclosed) as follows.

"32 (1) All government Institutions of Higher Education and other Higher Education Institutions receiving aid from the Government shall reserve not less than five percent, seats for persons with benchmark disabilities...

(2) The persons with benchmark disabilities shall be given an upper age relaxation of five years for admissions in institutions of higher education.

In accordance to the above, it is further resolved to honour the Supreme Court Directions, and to adopt 5% reservations to the physically handicapped with bench mark disabilities in each group i.e. OC, BC, SC, and ST for admission in all academic programs offered by the University, as specified in Section 32 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 (Central Act No. 49) 32 (1) and 32 (2).
