REGULAR AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

REGULAR AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

- 1. <u>Plantation</u>: The NSS Cell of Kakatiya University has organized Plantation drive in the three districts in connection with the Telangana Haritha Haraam (THH) and Vanamahotsav Week Celebrations, we organized plantation on the University Campus and college units in United three districts i.e. Adilabad, Khammam and Warangal planted nearly 29,840 saplings. And it's worth in Rs. 98.34 lakh.
- 2. <u>Blood Donation</u>: Blood Donation Camps were organized by the NSS Units of three District Colleges the volunteers have donated in 18,750 Units of Blood to Indian Red Cross Society, Warangal and Blood Banks of MGM Hospital, Warangal and RIMS (Rajeev Gandhi Inst. of Medical Sciences), Adilabad and Govt. Civil Hospital, Khammam. The Volunteers both Male and Female have actively participated in these camps. A few of these were Inter-collegiate Blood Donation Camps. The donated blood units were used for the poor and needy especially for the Talasemia patients. The total donated blood units costs Rs. 2.20 crore approximately.

4. Health/Eye/ Immunisation Camps:

<u>Pulse Polio Programme:</u> The NSS volunteers have participated in Pulse Polio Programme and 84,641 Children were immunized against Polio in the villages of united three districts in the month of January 2019 and February 2019 and also created awareness programmes during Special Camps and in Regular activities.

Eye Care, Hanamkonda Branch and other Hospitals, were organized 14 camps in various colleges of Warangal district for NSS volunteers to check-up their eyes/ screening. More than 1027 volunteers were participated in the screening test. The camps organized in the months of October, November 2018.

<u>Drugs Abuse and Illicit Trafficking</u>: The NSS Cell of Kakatiya University concentrate on a new Programme namely 3G (Gudumba, Gutka and Gunja) and created awareness the adverse effect on the nervous system of addicted persons in the colleges as well as in the rural areas in three districts. Nearly 2093 programmes were conducted and more than 16,487 people were benefited through this programme.

REGULAR AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

- 1. <u>Plantation</u>: The NSS Cell of Kakatiya University has organized Plantation drive in the three districts in connection with the Telangana Haritha Haraam (THH) and Vanamahotsav Week Celebrations, we organized plantation on the University Campus and college units in three districts i.e. Adilabad, Khammam and Warangal planted nearly 26,875 saplings. And it's worth in Rs. 95.14 lakh.
- 2. <u>Blood Donation</u>: Blood Donation Camps were organized by the NSS Units of three District Colleges the volunteers have donated in 12,819 Units of Blood to Indian Red Cross Society, Warangal and Blood Banks of MGM Hospital, Warangal and RIMS (Rajeev Gandhi Inst. of Medical Sciences), Adilabad and Govt. Civil Hospital, Khammam. The Volunteers both Male and Female have actively participated in these camps. A few of these were Inter-collegiate Blood Donation Camps. The donated blood units were used for the poor and needy especially for the Talasemia patients. The total donated blood units costs Rs. 1.28 crore approximately.
