



2.0 Objective of the Award:

2.1 Bharat Ratna Sir M. Visvesvaraya Award

To recognise the outstanding contributions made by the recipient in the field of engineering and technology. To generate and encourage application of science and technology for promotion of material welfare of the people.

2.2 Engineer of the Year Award/Young Engineer of the Year Award

To the specific contribution in any particular fields of engineering which will indicate the development capabilities of the engineers.

3.0 Nature of the Awards:

3.1 Bharat Ratna Sir M. Visvesvaraya Award carries with it: (One)

- A citation to be read out at the Engineers' Day Function which will be celebrated by The Institution of Engineers (India), Telangana State Centre, Khairatabad, Hyderabad on 15th September of that year.

a) A Citation to each recipient to be read out at the Engineers' Day Function which is celebrated by the Institution of Engineers (India), Telangana State Centre, Khairatabad on 15th September of that year.

- b) Certificate of the Award for each recipient.
- c) A cash payment of Rs. 5,000/- each to be presented at the same Engineers' Day Function.

4.0 Eligibility and Criteria for the Award :

- 4.1 The residents of Telangana State engaged as Practicing Engineer or Technologist/Research Engineer/Engineering Teacher, are eligible for the Engineers Day Awards.
- 4.2 The outstanding work or research contribution made should primarily be in Telangana and should have been carried out during the five years immediately preceding the year of the Award for the benefit of the people of Telangana or should represent a specific break-through in the field of Engineering/Technology in Telangana State.
- 4.3 The Awards will be presented to the persons who in the final opinion of the Prize Award Selection Committee have made important and outstanding contribution, specific contribution in the field of the work of the candidate towards the welfare of the humanity in general and the people of Telangana in particular. For this purpose, specific contribution of individual in the field of Engineering and Technology will be the sole predominant criterion for evaluation.

Guidelines for Celebration of Engineers' Day

- 1. Engineers' Day which falls on September 15, every year is the Day of profound significance in theannals of Indian Engineering. On September 15, 1861 was born the Engineering Wizard of India, Bharat Ratna Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya. As a creative genius and a Man of determinedaction, he revolutionized the entire concept of planning for community welfare. With masterful expositions and achievements, the fields he covered are monumental, outreaching national frontiers. In this context, the celebrations on this day, rightly called the Engineers' Day as laiddown by the Council of the Institution are to be organised in such a way that every Engineers' Day should be a demonstration to the nation, especially to the engineers, to inculcate a sense of gratitude which, they hold Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya.
- 2. On this day all State Centres and Local Centres of the Institution should hold special meetingsspecifically devoted to highlight Sir M. Visvesvaraya's Life and exhort the Engineers to followhis footsteps in the overall interest of the engineering in India. The functions on this day shouldbe organised broadly on the following lines:
 - a) Inviting eminent personalities to preside over the function.
 - b) Garlanding the Photograph of Sir M. Visvesvaraya
 - c) Wide publicity through press and other media
 - d) Seminar, Technical meetings etc., based upon the Engineers' Day Theme.
 - e) Popularising the Life and Works of Sir M. Visvesvaraya in schools, colleges and otherorganisations within the area through lectures, exhibitions etc.,
