
Greetings from the Indian Council of Social Science Research, New Delhi.


You may perhaps be aware that the ICSSR has been offering National Fellowships to eminent Indian Social Scientists in recognition to their scholarly contributions and providing opportunities to engage themselves in full-time research enabling them to continue with their academic pursuits. To award National Fellowship, we invite nominations from a collegium constituted for the same. Renowned retired Indian social scientists who have not availed of ICSSR National Fellowship earlier, are eligible to be nominated for ICSSR National Fellowship. Direct applications for National Fellowships are not accepted. Nominating individuals should not forward more than two nominations against a Call. All nominations are to be accompanied by curriculum vitae of the scholar along with abstracts of 10 best publications and a 1000 words research proposal by the nominee.

National Fellowship is a full time research work for the duration of two years with the value of the fellowship as Rs.60, 000 p.m. and contingency grant as Rs.60, 000/- p.a. irrespective of the pensionary benefits. In view of the above, we would request you, as part of the collegium, to kindly send nominations (not more than two) to the ICSSR for this prestigious National Fellowship within one month from the date of this letter. For nomination please send your recommendation letter, curriculum vitae of the scholar and abstracts of his/her ten best publications and a 1000 words research proposal by the nominee.
