With reference to the KU Circular cited, I am to inform you that all the Principals of the University and Affiliated College of Kakatiya University to forward the prescribed application forms of the students who were seeking readmission into II, IV & VI Semesters of your college for the academic year 2025-2026.

Therefore, I am desired by the Vice-Chancellor to inform you that any deviation in implementing the readmission/promotion norms of the course at your college will be viewed seriously and imposed penal action against the colleges as per the norms. You are hereby informed to adhere the following norms for implementation scrupulously for the academic year 2025-2026:

- 1. Re-Admissions will be given well in advance on or before commencing classes of the Semester only. No application should be forwarded after a lapse of 15 days from the date of commencement of classes.
- 2. The Candidates who are detained in any semester for want of attendance or appearing exam / clearing no of backlogs as the case may be needs to fulfill the conditions first and after getting promotion only will be accorded readmission in the succeeding academic years as per the eligibility.
- Readmission rules and course wise promotion rules are kept in KU Website for ready reference and for strict implementation.

GUIDELINES FOR SEEKING READMISSION TO CONTINUE THE COURSES

- 1. The candidates who were detained for not putting up required percentage of attendance in a particular semester (i.e., 75% or 65% as the case may be) is however eligible to seek admission in the same Semester provided he has at least 40% (50% in case of Professional Courses) attendance in each paper.
- 2. Such candidates are eligible for readmission only for one time. It cannot be given again.
- 3. The candidate have to not only put 75% of attendance and register for examination for each semester but also to appear for at least 1 paper in each Semester for promotion to the next Semester.
- 4. The candidate who have put up required % of attendance and applied <u>for the examinations</u> but not appeared for any of the papers is however eligible to seek readmission in that Semester for want of appearing the examinations in the same Semester and to continue the Course within time frame.
- 5. All the candidates have to apply for readmission well in advance i.e., before commencement of the semesters in which they wish to seek readmission.
- **6.** While forwarding the applications of such candidates, it is to be noted on the application the following particulars for consideration subject to the above norms.
 - i. Particulars of attendance of the candidate in each paper duly signed by the teachers concerned and attend by the Principal the College as the case may require.
 - ii. If the results of a Semester are not declared by the time of seeking readmission. The Principal has to certify whether the candidate appeared any of the papers in that Semester from the eligible for promotion to next semester/insist the candidate to get the certification from the Centre of Examination.
 - iii. Ascertaining of enclosures of attendance statement, memo of marks or certification of attending, single paper and T.C. etc.,
- 7. The penalty shall be imposed against the colleges in the following instances
 - i. If detained/discontinued candidates are permitted to continue the Course without prior approval of the University.
 - ii. If there is considerable delay in forwarding the application of readmission i.e., in the middle of the Semesters by permitting the candidate to attend the classes.
 - iii. If application of any detained/discontinued candidate is forwarded for university examinations without readmission/permission from the University.
