Sir/Madam,

In continuation of the KU letter under reference cited, I draw your attention to the letter under reference cited wherein the District Collector, Hanamkonda issued instruction that the Colleges/Managements and Principals, **shall not collect the Tuition Fee (RTF) Special Fee, not hold original Certificates and exam hall tickets of poor ST students who are eligible for Fee Reimbursement renewal as well as fresh students** as per Government rules issued time to time, failing which necessary steps will be taken against the College Managements/Principals for Blacklisting the concerned Colleges from scholarships scheme.

Further, the Commissioner of ST Welfare, TS, Hyderabad noticed that certain Colleges Management/Principals are insisting the poor ST students for payment of Tuition Fee students which is against Government Rules. The Department will reimburse the Tuition Fee of the Colleges, Managements concerned as per the eligibility.

In view of the above, all the College Principals and Management are directed not to collect the Tuition Fee (RTF) special fee, not to hold original certificates and exam hall tickets of poor **SC & ST** students who are eligible for fee reimbursement renewal as well as fresh students **“Hard Copy by District Officer”** without fail. Any deviation from the instruction of the Government will warrant action under C.C.A rules. The University will initiate action against the Institutions who are erroneously insisting the student for payment of fee in deviation of the above instructions.
